



Senior Student Awards

As a school we are extremely proud of the effort and achievements of students. To acknowledge high performance Senior awards are organized each year. Awardees receive a small trophy to keep and a perpetual trophy. Following presentation of the awards and photos, the perpetual trophies are collected and displayed in the school's trophy cabinet as an ongoing reflection of the breath of programs and skills that are valued by the school.

Criteria for Senior Students Awards

1. These awards are primarily for Year 6 students with the possibility for certain awards to be presented to Year 5 students eg. winner of Rostrum if in Year 5.
2. The criteria for all awards requires demonstration of the school rules and values (major or consistent non-compliance may render a student ineligible for an award):
 - Versatility We can adapt to change (growth mindset)
And are willing to 'have a go' (courage)
 - Respect We treat everyone in a kind, friendly manner.
 - Responsibility We care for our school, belongings and always do our best.
3. A final decision as to the issuing of an award will be made by the school's executive on advice from appropriate staff.
4. In order to maintain the element of merit, not all awards need be awarded each year.

Academic Excellence: Awarded to a student/s who has demonstrated outstanding application and achievement across his/her learning program.

Personal Endeavour: Awarded to a student/s who has demonstrated particular persistence towards achievement of personal goals.

Outstanding Citizenship: Awarded to a student/s who consistently demonstrated outstanding citizenship.

Sportsperson: Awarded to a student/s who has demonstrated outstanding sportsmanship and sporting achievement.

Arts: Awarded to a student/s who has demonstrated outstanding commitment to the Arts.

Band Musicianship: Awarded to a student who has demonstrated outstanding musicianship or commitment to the band program.

Language and Culture: Awarded to a student who has demonstrated outstanding achievement within the Indonesian program.

Information Technology: Awarded to a student who has demonstrated outstanding use of technology as an integrated learning tool.

Rostrum Award: Awarded for the most successful senior Garran student in the ACT Rostrum public speaking competition.

House Trophy: Awarded to the House that wins the annual point score.
